SAG HARBOR, JUNE 20, 2007 – *The Nature of Art* exhibition will open at Karin Sanders Fine Art in Sag Harbor on Saturday, June 30th with a reception for the artists between 5 and 7pm. The gallery’s largest group exhibition to date, the show focuses on our natural surroundings through a variety of media, including paint on canvas, photography and sculpture. *The Nature of Art* will include work by artists **Eric Demarchelier, Michael Souter, Millie Falcaro, Richard Bruce, Suzanne Opton, Edie Nadelhaft, Arlene Slavin, Matthew Riva, Angela Beloian and Sharon Wandel.**
